Your privacy is important to us. This statement discloses the information practices for this Web site, including what type of information is gathered and tracked, how the information is used, and with whom the information is shared.

Personal Information

In general, you can visit this site on the Internet without telling us who you are and without giving any personal information about yourself. You may choose to give us personal information in a variety of situations. For example, you may want to give us information, such as your name and address or e-mail, to allow us to contact you, to process an order, or to provide you with a subscription. We intend to let you know how we will use such information before we collect it from you; if you tell us that you do not want us to use this information to make further contact with you beyond fulfilling your requests, we will respect your wishes. If you give us personal information about somebody else, such as a spouse or work colleague, we will assume that you have their permission to do so.

Marketing Use

The information you provide may also be used by RENEW International for marketing purposes. Before we use it, however, we will offer you the opportunity to choose whether or not to have your information used in this way.

Mailing lists and e-mail preferences

We hope to be a helpful resource to you and your ministry and these mailings are our method of communicating what is available to you. RENEW International will occasionally send you e-mails with notices about our services, resources or upcoming events that might interest to you. We may also send brochures to your mailing address. We are sensitive to your desire not to receive spam and try our best to restrict mailings only to information that would be helpful to you. However, if you would prefer not to receive any e-mail or mail from us, please let us know by either clicking the "Unsubscribe from this mailing list" link at the footer of the email, sending an e-mail to the above e-mail address, or calling us at (908) 769-5400 and ask to be removed from our mail and e-mail list.

Please note that we do not sell or rent your contact information to other third-parties.

Information Security and Quality

We intend to protect your personal information and to maintain its quality. We implement appropriate measures and processes, such as using encryption when transmitting certain sensitive information, to help us to keep your information secure and to maintain its quality.

Cookies, Web Beacons and Other Technology

We sometimes collect non-identifiable information from visits to our Web sites to help us provide better customer service. For example, we keep track of the domains from which people visit, and we also measure visitor activity, but we do so in ways that keep the information non-identifiable. This information is sometimes

known as "clickstream data." We may use this data to analyze trends and statistics and to help us provide better customer service.

Also, when we collect personal data from you in a transaction, we may extract some information about that transaction in a non-identifiable format and combine it with other non-identifiable information such as clickstream data. This information is used and analyzed only at an aggregate level to help us understand trends and patterns. This information is not reviewed at an individual level. If you do not want your transaction details used in this manner you can disable your cookies.

We collect the information we mentioned in the previous paragraphs through the use of various technologies, including one called "cookies". A cookie is a piece of data that a Web site can send to your browser, which may then be stored on your computer as an anonymous tag that identifies your computer but not you. Some pages may use cookies to better serve you when you return to the Web site. You can set your browser to notify you before you receive a cookie, giving you the chance to decide whether to accept it. You can also set your browser to turn off cookies. If you do so, however, some Web sites may not work properly.

If you turn off cookies, Web beacon and other technologies will still detect visits to these pages, but the notices they generate cannot be associated with other non-identifiable cookie information and are disregarded.
